Notice of track closure: A1 North Side (near Skateraw)

To facilitate the construction of haul roads, trenching, and pipework ducting, and ensure public safety, we must temporarily restrict access to the track on the north side of the A1 near Skateraw.

Periodic closure of the track is scheduled to begin on 30 March 2026 and is expected to continue until 2028.

Commitment to access

We understand how important this route is to the local community and appreciate your patience while these works take place. Due to the heavy machinery and construction activities involved, the temporary closure is necessary to ensure the safety of both the public and our workforce. However, this is not intended to be a permanent closure.

EGL1 and our lead contractor, Prysmian, are committed to reopening the track periodically throughout the two-year construction period whenever it is safe and practical to do so. We will continue to review opportunities to allow access and will keep the community informed of any updates.

Due to the flexible and evolving nature of the construction programme, it may not always be possible to provide long advance notice of these reopening periods. However, we are committed to being transparent and to sharing updates as early as practicable, including confirmation of reopening dates, through our usual communication channels.

Safety information

Because the site is positioned between active construction and the A1, unfortunately we are unable to provide a safe alternative diversion at this specific location. We sincerely apologise for this inconvenience and thank you for your continued patience as we deliver this green energy infrastructure.
