

Berwick Bank Planning Applications Update (7 April 2026)

Following our recent application to East Lothian Council for the installation of 275kV underground cables between the landfall and the onshore substation (275kV works) earlier this year. I am writing to confirm that this application was approved on the 31st March 2026.

I previously wrote to explain that we have two other applications to be submitted, one of which has now occurred. Berwick Bank Wind Farm Ltd have submitted an application under the Town and Country Planning (Scotland) Regulations for the Approval of Matters Specified in Conditions relating to our proposals to construct an onshore substation in the Innerwick area. This application provides more detailed information regarding our onshore proposals within East Lothian and it can be viewed and commented on by entering the application ref 26/00304/AMM into the following planning portal - [Simple Search](#)

We will submit a further application later in the year relating to the installation of 400kV underground cables between the substation and the grid connection point at Branxton (the 400kV Cable Works). I will write to you once this has been submitted as is available for view and comment.
