Essential Maintenance for Safer, Reliable Journeys: Overnight Resurfacing at A1 South of Innerwick Junction

Date: 26/05/2026

WHAT'S HAPPENING

BEAR Scotland, on behalf of Transport Scotland, is committed to maintaining and improving the trunk road network in your area. As such, we will be undertaking essential overnight carriageway resurfacing on the A1 in both directions, south of Innerwick Junction, located approximately 3 miles south of Dunbar.

WHEN

These works are scheduled to take place over **19 nights from Monday 8th June to Thursday 2nd July, from 19:30 to 06:00 each night**. No works are currently planned for Saturday or Sunday nights.

HOW WE'LL MANAGE IT

For the safety of road users and our workforce, **a 10mph convoy traffic management system will be in place in both directions**.

Traffic restrictions:

The A1 will remain open during these essential works, however a 10mph convoy traffic management setup will be in place in both directions. The A1 southbound dual carriageway will be restricted to a single lane on approach to the site during the works.

Additionally, during working hours right-turn restrictions will be in place at Innerwick Junction. Traffic from Innerwick junction heading southbound on the A1 will be diverted northbound to Spott Roundabout and then back on the A1 southbound. This diversion will add 3 minutes and 2.9 miles onto affected journeys.

Engagement undertaken with local residents, community councils and representatives in this area of the A1 has guided the selection of alternative traffic management for these works and the format of the programme. We would like to take this opportunity to thank the local community for their patience whilst these essential works are undertaken.

Please note: Dates and durations may be subject to change due to weather or unforeseen circumstances. Emergency vehicle access will be maintained at all times.

OUR COMMITMENT

We understand that roadworks can be disruptive, and we are committed to completing this work as efficiently and safely as possible. Your patience and understanding are greatly appreciated as we carry out these vital improvements.

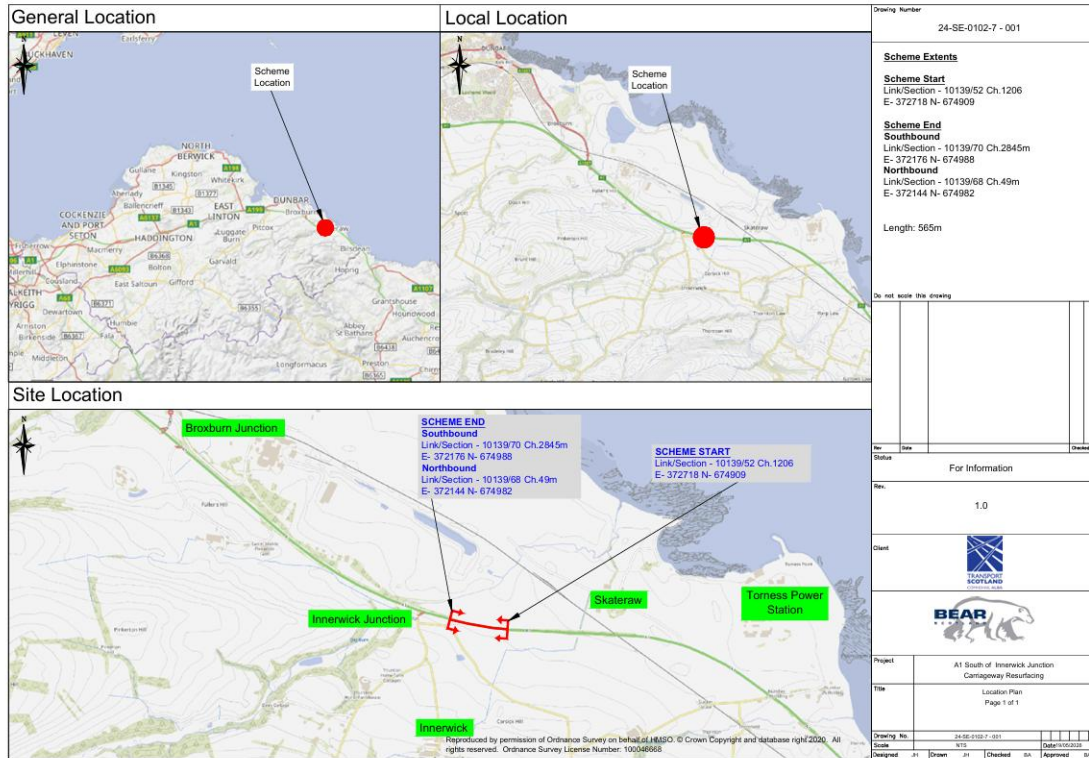
